Average monthly weather forecast los angeles

Boston is known for having four distinct seasons, with notable differences between spring, summer, fall and winter. When you visit will depend on what you are looking to see in the city, and your preference on the weather will be a factor in this decision. Spring and autumn are when you find the most comfortable weather, with peaks in the 60s in May and October. December to February are when you can expect to see the coldest weather, but if you head to Boston looking for snow, this is your best bet. April showers are a reality in Boston - this month tends to be the wettest month, although Boston doesn't have incredible amounts of rain. In late April and May, you will probably experience the best of spring with the sun shining during the day and temperatures in the 1960s. Keep in mind that it will still be cold at night. **What to pack:** Your packaging list from March to May will vary a lot. In March, you'll probably still want to pack your winter jacket. As you enter in April and May, the spring layers will be your go-to.
